#### □ 22-1. Converting adjectives into attributes

An attribute is a word that represents a quality or characteristic of something. This can be the length, the color, the height etc.

You can make pretty much any adjective into an attribute with the following pattern.

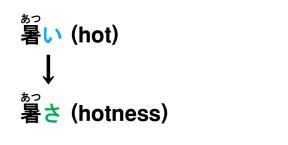
Here are some common examples:

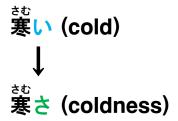
たかい (tall) ↓ たかさ (height)

#### □ 22-2. Some interesting attributes

Length, width, and height etc are pretty simple easily thought of attributes. But some words might not be make sense at first glance.







Let's look at how words like "hotness" and "coldness" might work.

# この暑さは信じられない!

I can't believe this heat!

# 温度は同じだけど、昨日と今日の寒さが違う。

The temperature is the same, but the cold of yesterday and today are different.

#### □ 22-3. Non adjective attributes

Not all attributes are created with adjectives. Here are a few:

幅 (width)

しんちょう 身長 (height) \* of body

<sup>ぁヾゅ</sup> 奥行き (depth, length)

#### □ 22-4. Other useful attributes

Here are some other useful attributes that you will certainly hear in Japanese:

### セクシーさ (sexiness)

ゅんこく 韓国の KPOP アイドルのセクシーさは世界一です。

Korean KPOP idols sexiness is #1 in the world.

### 大きさ (bigness) (size)

この箱の大きさはちょうどいいです。

The size of this box is just right.

## <mark>優しさ (kindness)</mark>

この家には優しさが足りないです。

There isn't enough kindness in this house.
